Lions Clubs International North Carolina - Multiple District 31 Promotions Committee Official Minutes

Saturday August 7, 2004 1:00 PM Holiday Inn, Salisbury, NC

State Promotions Committee Chairman, PDG David C. Boyd, Jr, called the first meeting of the 2004-2005 State Promotions Committee to order.

District Governor F. James Boehm gave the Invocation and **District Governor Pat Roland** led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Boyd recognized Past International Directors, **Harold Stallings, Lacy Presnell and Sid Scruggs**. PID's Harold and Lacy had no comments; PID Sid Scruggs deferred his comments until later into the meeting.

Chair Boyd appointed **DG Hunter Garbee** as Parliamentarian.

Immediate Past Promotions Chair, **PDG Clarence Williford**, gave his final report for the year 2003-2004. (See attachment "A")

A motion was made by DG Gene Everette and seconded by DG Hunter Garbee to approve the Minutes of the May 1, 2004 Promotions Meeting. Motion Approved.

Promotions Secretary-Treasurer George Ohm, PDG gave the **2003-04 Year-end Financial Report**. **DG Pat Roland moved to approve the Report, seconded by DG Allen King**. PID Lacy suggested removing the \$700 cost of The Piper Band from the Promotions Reserve Expenses to a separate line item. **DG Pat Roland amended her motion to include moving the cost of the Piper band to a separate line Item. DG Hunter Garbee seconded the amendment.**Both the amendment and the original motion passed.

PST Ohm presented the **2004-05 Promotions Committee Budget**. Notable changes include increasing the travel budgets for Promotions Chair and Secretary Treasurer to Hong Kong to \$4000.00 each, and reducing the cost of State Trading Pins to \$7000 due to reduced purchases. **PDG David Butler** suggested correcting the Proposed Income from State Trading Pins by deleting \$937.50 for the 625 free pins given to VDGs, PID's and the pin designer. **DG Hunter Garbee moved to accept the Amended Budget; seconded by DG Allen King. Motion Passed.** (See attachment "C")

Chair Boyd commented on the 2005 Hong Kong Convention. He stated that South Carolina again approached us on a combined Breakfast in Hong Kong. PID Lacy cautioned that any combined functions at the International Convention could cause negative perceptions by other delegates. He suggested we should consider an informal breakfast with NC Lions only. DG Jams Boehm followed with a motion to have only an informal Breakfast at the convention. No second as offered.

DG Pat Roland moved <u>to not</u> have a North Carolina Lions Breakfast; seconded by CC Jim Shuart. Motion Passed

Chair Boyd raised the question of a Hospitality Room at the Convention. The topic was tabled.

Chair Boyd stated that upon recommendation of Immediate Past Promotions Chair, PDG Clarence Williford, only 7000 - 2005 "Race Car" State Trading Pins were ordered.

PDG Dave Butler presented sketches of the proposed 2006 "Football" State Trading Pin. Estimated cost is in the range of \$1.00 -\$1.05 for a lot of 6500 pins. **DG Keith Peedin moved to accept the design and authorize the making of samples for the November meeting; seconded by CC Jim Shuart. Motion passed.**

PID Lacy questioned whether we planned to have a special pin for PID Sid if he is elected in New Orleans. It was suggested to consider this at a later date.

PID Sid commented on the Budget used for Past President Bill Woolard's campaign. He is also querying recent International Officers on their campaign budgets. PID Sid reported that past practice was to raise dues by \$1.00 for candidate campaigns, however when PIP Woolard ran we had 13,000 Lions, we now have less than 10,000.

DG Gene Everette made a motion to increase State Promotions dues by \$2.00 per year to start July 1, 2005 and proceed through June 30, 2009. All proceeds are to be placed in a Campaign Savings Account. The dues increase will terminate June 30, 2006, if there is no candidate. Motion seconded by DG Allen King. Motion Passed. (This motion will be sent to the Constitution and by-laws Committee for presentation to and voting by the Lions attending 2005 State Convention.

The next Promotions Committee Meeting will be held at the Holiday Inn , Rocky Mount, November 13, 2004

The meeting adjourned at 2:15 PM
